




# Where to Find Us



## About Us

The North Lakeland Discovery Center's 63-acre campus surrounds pristine Statehouse Lake and is part of the 240,000 acre Northern Highland State Forest in Wisconsin's Northwoods.



Residing on the grounds of a former Youth Conservation Corp (YCC) camp, the property features a **renovated lodge** with fully equipped **commercial kitchen**, dining room, **eight newly remodeled bunkhouses**, two classroom cabins and a hands-on nature center, along with a lakeside amphitheater, campfire ring and sandy swimming beach.

The grounds include more than **12 miles** of hiking, biking, XC ski and snowshoe trails, and a **17-station**, self-guided interpretive nature trail and bog boardwalk.


